

How to become a Member of PhoSciNet

- (1) Your country must have signed the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).
- (2) You must agree with the objectives of PhoSciNet (see link on Home page)
- (3) Identify the Working Group that matches most closely your own research program. For a description of the five Working Groups use the links at the bottom of the Home page.
- (4) To evaluate whether you can strengthen the Working Group of choice you should examine the member lists that are given on the Working Groups page.

Selection criteria for new Working Group members

- (1) The new member must strengthen the Working Group in which he/she wants to participate.
- (2) The expertise of the new member should be complementary to that of the current members of the Working Group.
- (3) The applicant must have a strong publication record in the proposed area over the past five years.
- (4) The applicant must convincingly state his/her interest in phosphorus sciences and in the Working Group he/she wants to participate.

Procedure

- (1) The application must file the application before October 31, 2010 with the Chair of PhoSciNet, Prof. E. Hey-Hawkins.
- (2) The Chair consults the Leader of the Working Group.
- (3) The Chair conducts an e- voting among the Working Group members.
- (4) The applicant is informed of the result of the e-vote.
